

## Yankee-Owned Estates in France's Premier Region

The Bordeaux estates profiled below all operate under American ownership. They are organized in order of purchase date, historically to most recent. The numeral preceding the château name correlates to the property's placement on the accompanying map.

- 1** **Château Monbrison** | Margaux | Cru Bourgeois  
Purchased in 1921 by Robert Davis, a professor, journalist and Red Cross operative, and his wife, Kathleen Johnston, of the négociant family; now run by Laurent Von der Heyden, their grandson. The property comprises 40 acres and makes 9,200 cases among its *grand vin* and a second red.
- 2** **Château Haut-Brion** | Pessac-Léognan | First-growth; Cru Classé de Graves  
Purchased in 1935 by financier Clarence Dillon; his great-grandson Robert de Luxembourg became president of Domaine Clarence Dillon in 2008. The property comprises 119.5 acres and makes 18,000 cases among its *grand vin*, a second red, a dry white wine and a second dry white.
- 3** **Château La Mission Haut-Brion** | Pessac-Léognan | Cru Classé de Graves  
Purchased in 1983 by Domaine Clarence Dillon. The property comprises 52 acres and makes 9,000 cases among its *grand vin*, a second red and a dry white.
- 4** **Château La Vieille Cure** | Fronsac  
Purchased in 1986 by investor Colin Ferenbach of Tocqueville Asset Management, and Peter Sachs, partner at Goldman Sachs; they were later joined by Goldman Sachs' Donald Gant. The property comprises 20 acres and makes 8,400 cases among its *grand vin* and a second red.
- 5** **Château Falfas** | Côtes de Bourg  
Purchased in 1988 by lawyer John Cochran and his wife, Véronique. The property comprises 50 acres and makes 8,300 cases among three reds.
- 6** **Château Haut-Bailly** | Pessac-Léognan | Cru Classé de Graves  
Purchased in 1998 by Robert Wilmers, chairman of M&T Bank, and his wife, Elizabeth. The property comprises 70 acres and makes 13,000 cases among three red wines.
- 7** **Château Pomeaux** | Pomerol  
Purchased by Albert Powers, chairman and CEO of Allied Pacific. First vintage was 1998.
- 8** **Château Haut-Beyzac** | Haut-Médoc  
Purchased in 1999 by Daren Miller; his wife, Emmanuelle Raguenot; and Miller's in-laws, Marie-Pierre Raguenot and Eric Lallez. The property comprises 65 acres and makes 16,700 cases among three red wines.
- 9** **Château des Tourtes** | Premières Côtes de Blaye  
Acquired in 2000 by Daren Miller, his wife and in-laws (see Haut-Beyzac). The property comprises 132 acres and makes 33,300 cases among three red wines, two dry whites and a rosé.
- 10** **Château Lagarosse** | Premières Côtes de Bordeaux  
Purchased in 2000 by Stephen Adams, owner of the Affinity Group cluster of camping and RV businesses, and his wife, Denise. The property comprises 81.5 acres and makes 12,500 cases of a single red wine.
- 11** **Château Lascombes** | Margaux | Second-growth  
Purchased in 2001 by Colony Capital pension fund. The property comprises 207.5 acres and makes 28,500 cases of *grand vin* and a second red.
- 12** **Château de Candale** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru  
Purchased in 2002 by Stephen and Denise Adams. The property comprises 27 acres and makes 4,000 cases of its *grand vin* and a second red.
- 13** **Château Lassègue** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru  
Purchased in 2003 by Kendall-Jackson owner Jess Jackson and his wife, Barbara Banke, with Pierre Seillan. The property comprises 59 acres and makes 9,300 cases among two red wines and a rosé.

- 14** **Château Fonplégade** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru Classé  
Purchased in 2004 by Stephen and Denise Adams. The property comprises 44 acres and makes 5,000 cases among its *grand vin* and a second red wine.
- 15** **Château La Gatte** | Bordeaux Supérieur  
Purchased in 2004 by former wine tradesman Michael Affatato and his wife, Hélène Fenouillet. The property comprises 28 acres and makes 7,500 cases among three reds, a dry white and a rosé.
- 16** **Château Armens** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru  
Acquired in 2005 by Tony Novelly of Apex Oil, with Alexandre de Malet Roquefort. The property comprises 39.5 acres and makes 2,900 cases of its *grand vin* and sometimes a second red wine.
- 17** **Château L'Enclos** | Pomerol  
Purchased in 2007 by Stephen and Denise Adams. The property comprises 24.5 acres and makes 3,900 cases of a single red wine.
- 18** **Château Roylland** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru  
Purchased in 2007 by Stephen and Denise Adams. The property comprises 24.5 acres and makes 3,300 cases of a single red wine.
- 19** **Château Tertre Daugay** | St-Emilion | Grand Cru Classé  
Acquired in 2007 by Tony Novelly, with Léo de Malet Roquefort. The property comprises 39.5 acres and makes 4,700 cases of its *grand vin* and sometimes a second red wine.
- 20** **Château de Bel-Air** | Lalande-de-Pomerol  
Purchased in 2005 by Stephen and Denise Adams. The property comprises 39.5 acres and makes 7,500 cases of a single red wine.
